Debi will take the stuffed backpacks home and stuff the remaining supplies to be purchased on the 15th and will then arrange with Nell to get the dropped off either to Nell or to the schools directly.

Debi Shannon offered the benediction and Marge Berrios adjourned the meeting at 8:15pm.
